




All electrical connections must be in accordance with all ordinances, Local and National Electrical Codes. These fixtures are intended for mounting to standard $4" \times 2 \frac{1}{2}"$ metal octagon outlet box. The box must be directly supported by the building structure and U.L Recognized.

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Before starting your installation disconnect the Power by turning off the Circuit Breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box. Just turning the light off at the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.


If there is an existing fixture remove it.

Secure the crossbar to the J-box with the supplied screws. Ensure that the additional screws face downwards.

CONNECT THE WIRES

Connect the black supply wire to the black fixture wire. Secure with the supplied wire nuts. Connect the white supply wires to the fixture wire. Secure with the supplied wire nuts. Either wrap the green wire around of the protruding screws or connect it to the supply ground wire. Secure all wire with U.L Certified electrical tape (not supplied).



MOUNT THE CANOPY

Fit the fixture canopy up to the crossbar. Insert the hanging screws into the designated holes in the canopy. Secure with the supplied thumbscrews.



SECURE THE GLASS SHADE

Use the metal ring to secure the glass shade by the provided screws. Twist the top cover to secure the back plate unit.

This fixture is wet location rated. In order to ensure that moisture does not enter the outlet box and cause a short circuit, clear caulking should be used to seal the space between the fixture mounting bracket and the wall. Ensure that a space is left at the bottom to allow for the escape of moisture. It is recommended that Indoor/Outdoor Silicone Sealant be used for that purpose
